UTILITY ACCOUNT OVERDUE INTEREST

As per Bylaw No. 13/21, effective January 1, 2022, the interest rate for outstanding utility accounts over 30 days will be 5% per month. This has increased from 2% per month.

TAXES

The Town is offering tax discounts for prepayment of 2022 taxes. The following discounts will be applied to Municipal tax payments made during that month:

April- 3% May – 2% June – 1% If you have any questions feel free to call the office.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022

There will be a rate increase to water, sewer and recycling rates charged on the utility bills. You will notice this increase on your next utility bill mailed out on March 1, 2022.

For residential the rate increases are as follows (per billing):

Minimum Water Fee - \$105.60

Overage Rate for Water - \$9.80 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof

Sewer Fee - \$23.44

Recycling - \$14.00

The water and sewer rates are being increased to build up the utility reserve for future projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement or water treatment plant upgrades.

The recycling rates are being increased due to an increase being passed down to the town from Triways Disposal Services.

Summer Student Required

The Town of Eatonia requires a summer student to work in the Public Works Department to cut grass, tend to flowers and trees, and other miscellaneous duties.

CEMETERY BEE COMING IN MAY

With the countdown to July 1 underway, spring weather will inspire people to "spruce" up their yards in readiness for the anticipated influx of visitors to town.

We encourage a similar momentum at the cemetery as it too, will have many visitors. It is the enduring memorial for pioneers and heritage of the community. The oldest inscribed monument is dated 1919.

Check your family markers for ways to enhance their appearance to add to the presentation of the cemetery as a whole. A reminder that ornamentation not attached to a monument (flowers, wreaths, glassware, plaques) which hinders maintenance is not permitted as outlined in the town cemetery bylaw. A nice option for flowers and solar lights is the purchase of a vase to be fixed on the side of the monument. A metal wire saddle with florist foam works very well for an upright monument. The prairie wind is a constant so please keep it in mind!
