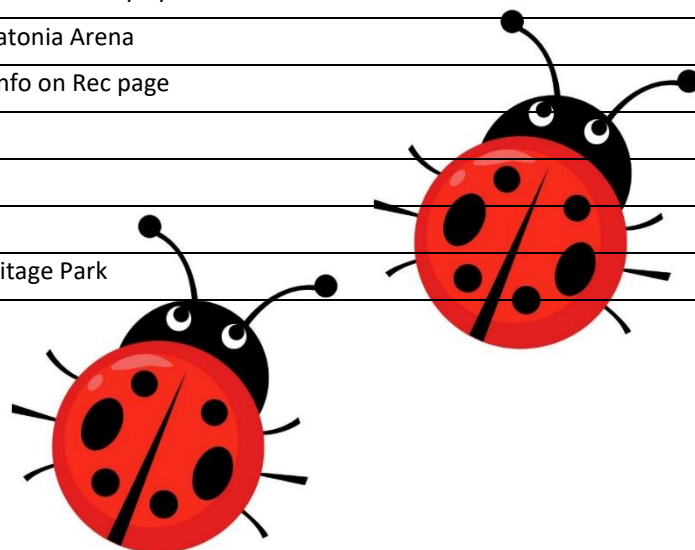

From July – December, 2022 a 1% Penalty per month will be charged on all current taxes still outstanding. In January, 2023 a 10% penalty will be charged on all outstanding taxes

### UTILITY ACCOUNT OVERDUE INTEREST

As per Bylaw No. 13/21, effective January 1, 2022, the interest rate for outstanding utility accounts over 30 days will be 5% per month. This has increased from 2% per month.

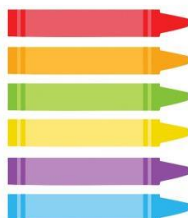
