### UTILITY ACCOUNT OVERDUE INTEREST

As per Bylaw No. 13/21, effective January 1, 2022, the interest rate for outstanding utility accounts over 30 days will be 5% per month. This has increased from 2% per month.

## EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022

There will be a rate increase to water, sewer and recycling rates charged on the utility bills. You will notice this increase on your next utility bill mailed out on March 1, 2022.

For residential the rate increases are as follows (per billing):

Minimum Water Fee - \$105.60

Overage Rate for Water - \$9.80 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof

Sewer Fee - \$23.44

Recycling - \$14.00

The water and sewer rates are being increased to build up the utility reserve for future projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement or water treatment plant upgrades.

The recycling rates are being increased due to an increase being passed down to the town from Triways Disposal Services.

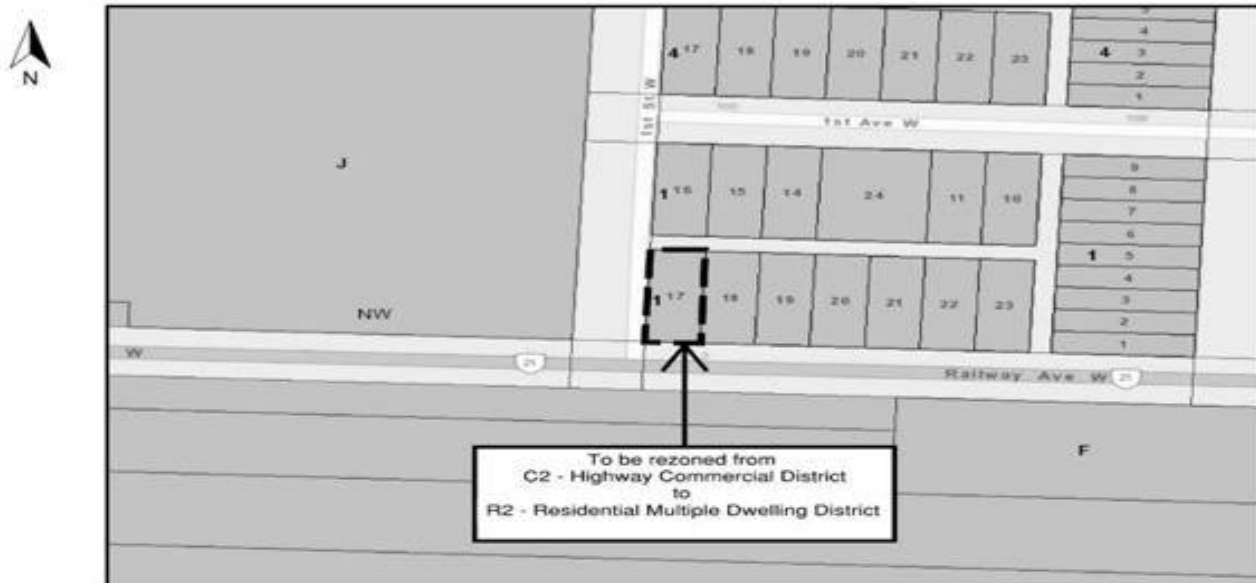
## TOWN OF EATONIA PUBLIC NOTICE

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Eatonia intends to adopt a bylaw under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* to amend Bylaw No. 5/16, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

### INTENT

The proposed Zoning Bylaw amendment will:

- Replace the definition for "Dwelling, Duplex"
- Reduce the required side yard setback in the CS – Community Service District
- Rezone Lot 17, Block 1 from C2 – Highway Commercial District to R2 – Residential Multiple Dwelling District Single Dwelling District



### REASON

The reason for the amendment is to:

- Provide for a wider range of residential development;
- Provide less restrictive yard requirements within the community service district; and,
- Provide additional clarity within the Zoning Bylaw.

### PUBLIC INSPECTION

Any person may inspect the bylaws at the Town Office, located at 202 Main Street, Eatonia, SK between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. Copies of the bylaws are available at the Town Office at a cost.

### PUBLIC HEARING

Council will hold a public hearing in conjunction with their regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. on February 8, 2022 at the Town of Eatonia Council Chambers – 202 Main Street, Eatonia, SK to hear any person or group who wishes to comment on the proposed bylaws. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the Town office to the undersigned prior to the hearing.

Kindersley RCMP has launched a camera registry for the Detachment area:

Community Assisted Policing Through Use of Recorded Evidence or **CAPTURE**.

This is a voluntary security camera registry that homeowners and business owners with either rural or urban addresses can log on and register their security camera location which will provide the RCMP with these locations. Security cameras often capture evidence that can assist in solving crimes. If the Kindersley RCMP have a crime that happens they can view the list of available cameras on the registry and contact the camera owner. By providing RCMP with camera locations it will greatly assist with investigations as well as the time needed to locate cameras which will help in ensuring those committing crime are held responsible.

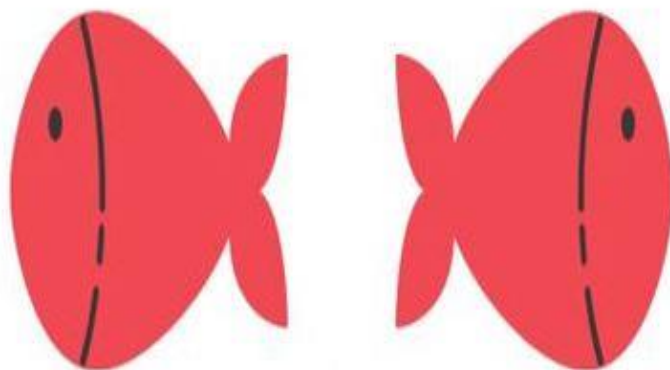

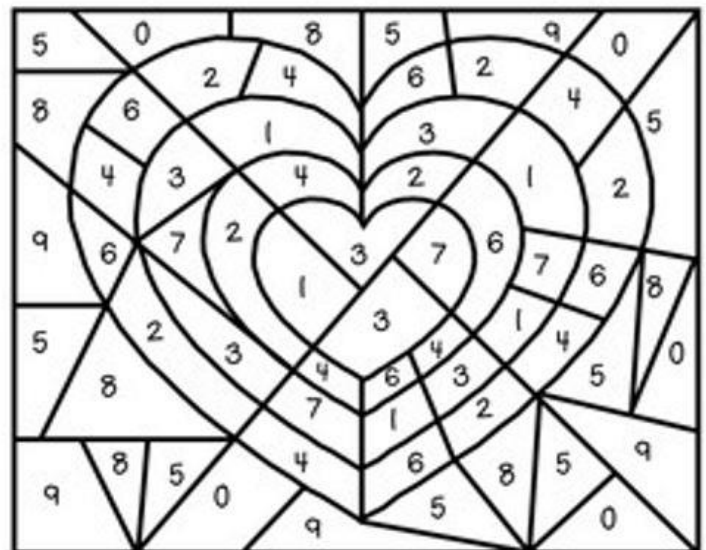
