#### TAXES

The Town is offering tax discounts for payment of 2022 taxes. The following discounts will be applied to municipal tax payments made during that month: June – 1% on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 a 1% penalty will be charged on all current taxes still outstanding

#### **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022**

There was a rate increase to water, sewer and recycling rates charged on the utility bills. You will notice this increase on your utility bill mailed out on March 1, 2022.

For residential the rate increases are as follows (per billing):

Minimum Water Fee - \$105.60

Overage Rate for Water - \$9.80 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof

Sewer Fee - \$23.44

Recycling - \$14.00

The water and sewer rates are being increased to build up the utility reserve for future projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement or water treatment plant upgrades.

The recycling rates are being increased due to an increase being passed down to the town from Triways Disposal Services.

#### UTILITY ACCOUNT OVERDUE INTEREST

As per Bylaw No. 13/21, effective January 1, 2022, the interest rate for outstanding utility accounts over 30 days will be 5% per month. This has increased from 2% per month.

On Wednesday, May 25, 2022 the Town of Eatonia sent out a notice to residents in town in regards to restricting water usage due to a mechanical issue at the water treatment plant. Residents would have received this notice by email, text and/or voice call.

If you did not receive this notice at all, it could be because you have not yet signed up for NECC (Newcombe-Eatonia-Chesterfield-Connect). NECC is a communication system that assists in sharing important local information. This system is used by the Town of Eatonia, R.M. of Chesterfield and R.M of Newcombe to communicate with residents by text, mobile phone, landline phone, and email but we need you to sign up for it.

Although this was not an emergency, we want to make sure that we are able to communicate with **ALL** residents of the municipality's if an emergency, such as a drinking water advisory, evacuation, fire emergency alert, etc. was to happen.
