UTILITY ACCOUNT OVERDUE INTEREST

As per Bylaw No. 13/21, effective January 1, 2022, the interest rate for outstanding utility accounts over 30 days will be 5% per month. This has increased from 2% per month.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022

There will be a rate increase to water, sewer and recycling rates charged on the utility bills. You will notice this increase on your next utility bill mailed out on March 1, 2022.

For residential the rate increases are as follows (per billing):

Minimum Water Fee - \$105.60

Overage Rate for Water - \$9.80 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof

Sewer Fee - \$23.44

Recycling - \$14.00

The water and sewer rates are being increased to build up the utility reserve for future projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement or water treatment plant upgrades.

The recycling rates are being increased due to an increase being passed down to the town from Triways Disposal Services.

Summer Students Required

The Town of Eatonia requires two summer students to work in the Public Works Department to cut grass, tend to flowers and trees, and other miscellaneous duties.

Recently a pilot project called FIRST has been introduced to our organization. This program looks at a wide variety of individual, family and community issues. This program is allowing for calls of concern to come to our office enabling us to approach the family or individual and assess or offer assistance. Our goal with this program is to get supports in place for people before circumstances get more intense requiring RCMP and emergency response. 




