

The pump needed to be replaced as the old pump did not have enough pressure to run the irrigation pivot properly. The new pump will allow the pivot to put more water on the field which in turn will create a higher yield. This higher yield will generate more proceeds for Eatonia Oasis Living. The Town of Eatonia rents the irrigation land to Eatonia Oasis Living at no charge.






