

Drinking Water Quality and Compliance Annual Notice to Consumers

The Water Security Agency requires that at least once a year, the town provides notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by the Permit to Operate a waterworks.

The Annual Notice to Consumers for the Town of Eatonia's water quality and sample submission for the 2022 calendar year can be viewed at the Town Office during regular office hours or visit the town's webpage at www.eatonia.ca.



The Town of Eatonia Council has passed a Golf Cart Bylaw No. 3/23 on July 11, 2023, which authorizes the operation of golf carts on public roads within town limits but does not include provincial highways except to cross the highway. This bylaw was subject to approval by Saskatchewan Government Insurance which they approved on July 17, 2023.

Golf carts can only be operated within town limits, subject to the following rules:

- Golf carts must be operated in accordance with the rules of the road as per The Traffic Safety Act;
- Golf carts cannot operate on any roadway with a posted speed of greater than 40 kms/hr and on any Provincial Highway except to directly cross the highway;
- All drivers must hold a minimum of a valid Class 7 driver's license (Learner) or higher driver's license;
- The owner is required to carry a minimum of \$200,000 in liability insurance for damages caused by the golf cart and must provide proof of insurance at the request of a Peace Officer, Bylaw Officer, or the Town Office;
- Must display a slow-moving vehicle sign;
- Only operate during daylight hours which is a half an hour before sunrise to a half an hour after sunset;
- Golf carts cannot be capable of operating at a speed of more than 24 km/hr;
- With more seated passengers than the design of the golf cart can safely handle, and in no event while a passenger is standing in or upon the golf cart;
- With a person being towed on any type of equipment attached to the golf cart.

Before you can operate a golf cart within town limits, you must obtain an annual permit from the Town Office which is in effect from January 1st to December 31st of the calendar year in which the permit was purchased. The annual fee for a permit is \$100.00. This permit is to be displayed on the side of your golf cart and is not to be transferred to any other golf cart.

When applying for a permit at the Town Office, please bring the make, model, serial number, year, and color of your golf cart. Also, before a permit will be issued you must also provide proof of \$200,000 liability insurance.

Every owner of a golf cart must report all collisions involving the golf cart to the Town Office within 72 hours of an accident, providing the full particulars of the collision including the time, date, and location, as well as the names and driver's license of all parties involved. The Town will inform SGI of any collision reported and if injuries or fatalities occurred.




