

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING RATE INCREASE

The town council approved a rate increase for garbage and recycling services in Eatonia at its December 13, 2022 council meeting.

The increase for residential and commercial customers is 10% per month. The adjusted rates take effect on January 1, 2023. You will notice this increase on the January-February billing which is mailed out at the beginning of March.

Garbage and recycling rates are reviewed annually to determine whether the rates are adequate to cover expenses or whether an increase is warranted. The town council takes every measure possible to avoid unnecessary increases in rates.

The main reasons for the increase is due the cost increase from the designated collector to cover their operating costs such as increased fuel costs, maintenance costs, landfill fees, etc. and to fund the town's share to decommission the landfill.

The rates will increase as follows:

Recycle cart collected bi-weekly	\$7.00	\$7.70	\$0.70

Also, please note that the garbage bins at the businesses, school, arena/pool, Corcoran Place and Eatonia Oasis Living are for their use only as they pay for the rental of these bins. THEY ARE NOT FOR PUBLIC USE SO PLEASE DO NOT DUMP YOUR GARBAGE IN THESE BINS.

You can dump garbage in your own garbage cart or take it to the nuisance grounds. The nuisance grounds hours for ratepayers of the Town of Eatonia and R.M. of Chesterfield are as follows:




