



Attention Town of Eatonia Residents:

Triways Disposal Services has contacted the Town Office to let us know that when they picked up the recycle bins at 102 – 2nd Avenue East behind the insurance office on May 11, 2023, there was yard waste such as grass clippings and branches in the bins. These bins are only for recycle items as per the list below:



SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Single-stream recycling is a system in which all recycle materials - fiber, plastics, tin and aluminum - are placed, unsorted, in the **BLUE** Recycle Cart or Container.



Cardboard, Boxboard, Office Paper, Newsprint, Junk Mail, Magazines and Catalogues



Plastic Containers, Milk Cartons & Plastic Milk Jugs

Plastics numbered 1 through 7 (No Food Containers labelled #1)
No oil containers or chemical jugs, no plastic wrap or bags



Tin and Aluminum Cans

(cans must be clean, with or without labels – no steel or auto parts)


NOTE: If you bag your grass clippings and set them out in the back alley along with tree branches, the town crew goes around once a month or more to pick up yard waste. There is no need to put this in the recycle bins/carts or your garbage cart.

You can also take it to the nuisance grounds yourself. The hours of operation of the nuisance grounds are as follows:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday – 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday – 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

TOWN OF EATONIA IMPORTANT SEWER SYSTEM NOTICE CLOGGING THE SYSTEM



The Town of Eatonia has been experiencing operational problems with public sewer mains. The cause of the problem relates directly to the products and materials discharged from residents to the Town's public sewer mains.

Baby wipes, feminine products, cleaning and disinfectant wipes, toilet cleaning brush disposable heads, and paper towels might be labelled as disposable or flushable, but these items must not go down the toilet drain. These products do not break down in the sewer system and can cause plugs in sewer pipes resulting in sewer backups.

In addition to these products, please avoid disposing of grease and cooking oils down the drain. When fats, oils and grease are poured or flushed down your sinks, drains or toilets they enter the sewer system where they cool, harden and stick to the inner walls of the sewer pipes. This can lead to blockages that are difficult and costly to fix.

When in doubt, use the tree Ps rule, flush pee, poo and paper (toilet paper) only!

On Tuesday, May 23, 2023, the Town of Eatonia sent out a notice asking residents not to park on the streets to allow the sweepers to clean the town streets. Residents would have received this notice by email, text and/or voice call.

If you did not receive this notice at all, it could be because you have not yet signed up for NECC (Newcombe-Eatonia-Chesterfield-Connect). NECC is a communication system that assists in sharing important local information. This system is used by the R.M. of Newcombe, Town of Eatonia and R.M. of Chesterfield to communicate with residents by text, phone and/or email but we need you to sign up for it.

Although this was not an emergency, we want to make sure that we are able to communicate with ALL residents of the municipality's if an emergency, such as a drinking water advisory, evacuation, fire emergency alert, etc. was to happen. **This system will also be used by the municipalities to send out emergency alerts from the RCMP.**

WOOD PELLETS FOR LITTER BOXES it's a game changer!

Like so many people we spent \$19-\$25 for a box of litter for years and years. Presently it's hard to find certain types of litter and prices are going up. I wanted to share with you a tip that was passed along to me.

Wood pellets can be used for litter boxes and this will change your pocket book forever! We have been using wood pellets for about 9 months and love it for our cat. The training takes about 3 weeks as you add it slowly to whatever you are using and also add whenever you scoop out clumps.

Watch the two You Tube video's below as they are both very informative. We bought 2 of the same size pans and used bolts/washers to rise it up instead of wooden blocks as in one of the video's.


We bought our wood pellets at Peavy Mart in Kindersley but I also found them at Home Depot. Peavy Mart is appx. \$6-\$9 for 40lbs. Home Depot is pretty much the same price for 40 lbs. I would call ahead though to make sure they have them in inventory.

It's a smart idea when you do buy them to get a lot as they go fast for other uses. We ended up after our cat was trained buying 13 bags and since last August roughly we have used 5 40lbs bags which equaled \$40 appx. as we bought ours on sale for appx. \$7 a bag at Peavy Mart. You want the wood pellets for stoves not BBQ's totally different prices. Spruce Pointe is the brand we used. I am currently also looking around for other places in case inventories aren't replenished because of shortages.

No more clay in the house or trailed around from a cats paws. It smells better, mind you when your cat does a number 2 it will still have a slight odor here and there. When the cat pee's it just expands the pellets and turns to saw dust and it drops down the holes into the bottom pan. It happens naturally when they dig. We still scoop every other day and we sift the pans every 4-6 days depending how many cats you have. We also put in 2 inches of pellets in the cats pan.



