

There have been some concerns about where the recycled items go when Triways Disposal Services picks up the carts from the Town. All recycled items go back to the Triways Disposal Depot in Swift Current. They sort it before it is baled and shipped out to various locations to recycle and reuse. It does not go to the Swift Current Landfill.

The Town was approved for a grant under the Provincial Traffic Safety Fund Grant Program to install blinker signs in the playground area between the pool and arena and at Melville Park. The funding also included installing a flashing beacon at the corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street East and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue East and replacing the school zone and playground area signs. Thank you to the Government of Saskatchewan for this funding.
