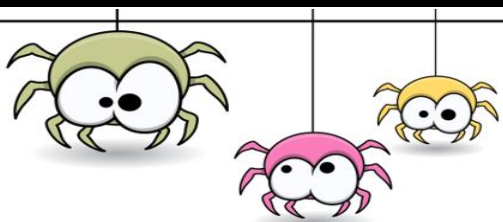

Summer Projects in Eatonia Cemetery

A beautiful, decorative metal sign *Honouring All Those Who Served* in the forces, crafted by E & G Welding, was erected. It was funded with a donation from the Centennial Committee. We again recognise their dedicated effort for that memorable celebration of July 2022 and extend our gratitude for their support in this very special tribute. As well, recognition for the labour involved is due Jim Martin, Bryan Somerville, Kevin Stevens, Wade Stevens, Jeff Stevens and Kevin Quinney.



In light of extreme grasshopper damage to the trees last year, aggressive preventative measures were a primary focus. These included early June aerial spraying and several applications of Eco-bran in following weeks. Ted Miller kept the grass neatly mowed. All this proved effective with small infestations kept in check. Disappointingly, a large number of lilac bushes will need to be replaced in the spring.

The restoration project in Blocks 1 and 2 was completed by a professional monument company. Several deteriorated concrete grave covers were removed and over 275 monuments were lifted, levelled or righted in whatever manner was required. The work was hugely labour intensive, time consuming and although reasonably contracted, still costly. Some families have expressed their appreciation with helpful monetary donations for which we are ever so grateful. The relief station, provided by Sam Somerville, was also much appreciated.

The Cemetery Committee of Darcy Scott, Cheryl Bailey, Matt McKinnon, Leah Cooper, Brent Watts, Jerry & Bernice Radies and Jim & Belva Martin are pleased to welcome Brent Bews, member-at-large.

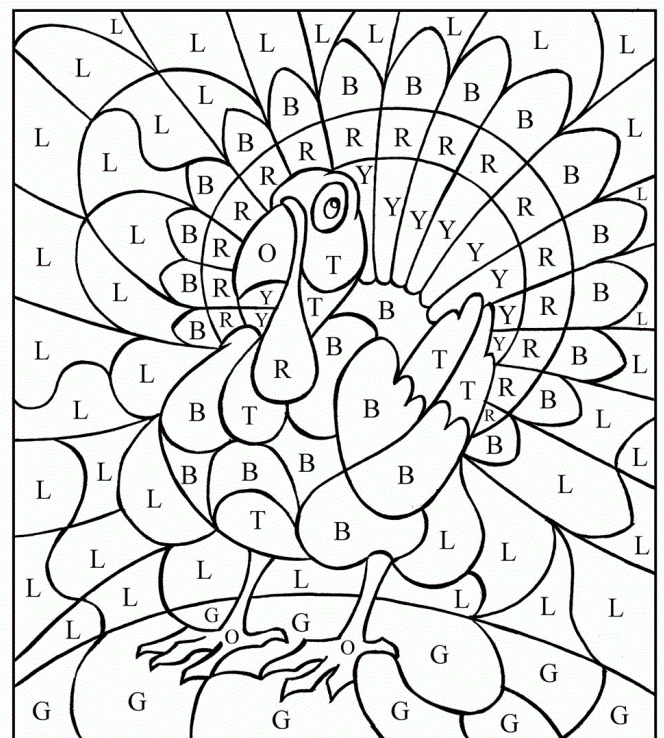
