Swedish Cookie Recipe

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons maple syrup
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- Confectioners' sugar
- Preheat oven to 300°. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy, 5-7 minutes. Add syrup. Combine flour and baking soda; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well.
- Divide dough into eight portions. Roll each portion into a 9-in. log. Place 3 in. apart on ungreased baking sheets. Bake 25 minutes or until lightly browned. Cut into 1-in. slices. Remove to wire racks. Dust with confectioners' sugar.

NEW IN EATONIA CEMETERY



A highlight of this summer was the installation of a second 16-niche columbarium – a twin to the existing one. Upon its arrival from Regina, Matthew Hoffman and Darcy Scott ably placed it in position with the use of a picker truck owned by Hoffman Land and Cattle. Their donation of time, expertise and equipment deserves a huge thank you – our financial saving was significant!

Spring initiated a planting project of 210 two-foot lilacs to replace those lost to grasshoppers in 2023. Intensive watchfulness ensued with active measures to prevent another year of losses. Happily, problems were minimal. Perhaps nature stepped in ... crickets were in great abundance ... do crickets eat grasshopper eggs?

Concrete runners were constructed in Block 5 in two rows of extremely irregularly placed monuments. The new straight rows, as well as being more visually pleasing, will be helpful in maintenance.

Regarding monuments, before making a purchase, families are urged to contact the town office for new guidelines on installation. Also, ornamentation which hinders maintenance, and which may present a public hazard (i.e. glass containers) is not permitted. Please respect these important issues.

We want to acknowledge two retiring committee members who have given up their seats on their respective councils. Brent Watts has been a great asset since our formation in 2018. Matt McKinnon has promoted us well since 2022. We are sorry to lose them.

The congenial support in labour and equipment from the Town of Eatonia employees and those from the R.M. of Chesterfield has been invaluable and is greatly appreciated.

As has been said before, we rely on donations for funding. Personal monetary contributions for the construction of the runners were most gratifying. Community generosity through Donor's Choice is ever heartwarming.
