*PLEASE READ YOUR AD***ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW NO. 6/23**

At the October 10, 2023, council meeting, the town council passed a new Animal Control Bylaw No. 6/23 which came into effect on January 1, 2024.

Some of the significant changes are as follows:

- Every owner of a dog or cat six (6) months old or older must register that animal with the Town Office. The repealed bylaw was four (4) months.
- Owners of animals are only required to pay a one-time fee to license their animal with the Town. The repealed bylaw was an annual fee. The animal license fees have not changed. They are as follows:
 - Neutered Dog or Cat \$15.00
 - Dog or Cat (Intact/Not Neutered) \$20.00
 - Replacement Tag \$5.00

When applying or renewing a license, please provide the following information:

- A physical description of the animal;
- A photo of the animal;
- The breed or type of the animal;
- The sex, and information regarding whether the animal is spayed/neutered or intact;
- Any other relevant information such as tattoo, microchip, unique markings, or medical conditions required with respect to the animal;
- The name, address, and telephone number(s) of the owner of the animal.
