TOWN OF EATONIA PUBLIC NOTICE

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Eatonia intends to adopt a bylaw under *the Planning* and Development Act, 2007 to amend Bylaw No. 5/16, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

INTENT

The proposed bylaw amendment will:

- add "sea containers" as an accessory discretionary use within the C1 Town Centre Commercial District.
- add "sea containers" as a discretionary use within the CS Community Service District.

REASON

The reason for the amendment is to:

- allow for the use of a sea container as an accessory discretionary use in the C1 Town Centre Commercial District.
- allow for the use of a sea container as a discretionary use within the CS Community Service District.

PUBLIC INSPECTION

Any person may inspect the bylaw at the Town Office, located at 202 Main Street, in the Town of Eatonia, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Monday to Friday excluding statutory holidays. Copies of the proposed bylaw are available at the Town Office at cost.

PUBLIC HEARING

Council will hold a public hearing on July 9, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Eatonia Council Chambers, 202 Main Street, Eatonia, SK to hear any person or group who wishes to comment on the proposed bylaw. Written submissions must be received by July 4, 2024, by 5:00 p.m. either by email or delivered to the Town Office.

The Town of Eatonia has passed a bylaw that will allow carts to operate on the roads within town limits where the posted speed limit is not greater than 40 km/hr, which came into effect upon approval from SGI.

There are certain rules in place before you can operate a golf cart within town limits:

- The driver of the golf cart must hold at least a valid Class 7 licence;
- The owner of the golf cart is required to carry a minimum of \$200,000 in liability insurance;
- Golf carts must display a slow-moving vehicle sign;
- Golf carts can only be operated during daylight hours;
- Golf carts cannot be capable of operating at a speed of more than 24 km/hr; and
- Every owner of a golf cart must obtain a permit from the town office. A permit will be given when proof of insurance is provided. The permit must then be displayed on the side of the golf cart. The annual fee for a permit is \$100.00.

The rules of the road as set out in *The Traffic Safety Act*, will apply to golf carts, the same as they do for any other vehicle on the road. Traffic violations such as speeding, stunting, impaired driving, etc. will apply to the driver's license and will therefore incur the same penalties as if the violation has occurred while driving any other vehicle.

Golf Cart Bylaw No. 3/23 can be viewed at the town office or on the town's website, www.eatonia.ca. If you have any questions in regard to the operation of a golf cart within town limits, please contact the town office.
