

#### WATER AND SEWER RATE INCREASE

Effective January 1, 2024, there will be a water and sewer rate increase charged on the utility bills. You will notice this increase on your next utility bill mailed out on March 1, 2024.

For residential the rate increase is as follows per month:

CHARGE	NEW RATE	OLD RATE	INCREASE
Water Fee	\$58.08	\$52.80	\$5.48
Sewer Fee	\$12.89	\$11.72	\$1.17
Water Overage Rate	\$10.78 per 1000 gallons or part thereof	\$9.90 per 1000 gallons or part thereof	

Water and sewer revenue is to cover operating expenditures which includes waterworks' staff salaries, benefits, and training; power, heat; insurance; chemicals; repairs; maintenance; supplies; etc. and to build up a reserve for future capital projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement or water treatment plant upgrades.

The Council is working towards water and sewer work revenues that cover water and sewer works expenditures and capital purchases. To accomplish this, the rates need to increase over time so that the revenues cover operating and capital costs.

Waterworks are to be self-financing, where the users pay for the costs of the service. Self-financing utility works will reduce pressure on property taxes.

Must have valid driver's license.



## From the Eatonia Community Hall Board

Since the hall was built in 1999, a community hall board has been tasked with the upkeep and maintenance of the building and grounds. We consist of members from the Town of Eatonia, the Eatonia and District Recreation Board, the Eatonia Oasis Players, the Eatonia Lions Club, the Eatonia Catering Committee and the Eatonia Cooperative.

In 2015, we had the inside of the hall painted, with the kitchen and bathrooms being painted and tiled in 2022. In 2016, a hot water on demand system was installed. In 2020, the stage floor was repainted. In 2021, the furnaces and a/c units were replaced as well as the ceiling tiles and the carpeted flooring. In 2022, the Gem Stone lights were installed and under stage storage was expanded.

Ceiling leaks have been happening for the last 2 years in the main hall area, so we have tried the local electrical and plumbing companies for possible fixes on the roof around the old a/c units. Nothing has worked to stop the leaking so now we have called roofing companies to get their professional opinions on where the leaks could be coming from. We have come to the consensus that the best way to proceed is to have the upper roof and insulation replaced. We are in the process of getting quotes and it looks like it will cost approximately \$200,000. We are getting final quotes in the next few weeks.

We have had a tremendous start to the fund raising by Randi McKinnon, Mandy Lavallee, Amber Ward and "Deaner the Dog". If your business or community group is looking for somewhere to donate this year, we would really appreciate anything you can give. Thank You so much! By doing this we hope to have the hall in good condition for many years to come.

As of March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 the office off the meeting room will be available for rent. If you need office space, please apply to the Town of Eatonia.
