GARBAGE AND RECYCLING Rate Increase

The town council approved a rate increase for garbage and recycling services in Eatonia at its November 12, 2024, council meeting.

The increase for residential and commercial customers is 10% per month. The adjusted rates take effect on January 1, 2025. You will notice this increase on the January- February billing which is mailed out at the beginning of March.

Garbage and recycling rates are reviewed annually to determine whether the rates are adequate to cover expenses or whether an increase is warranted. The town council takes every measure possible to avoid unnecessary increases in rates.

The main reasons for the increase is due to the cost increase from the designated collector to cover their operating costs such as increased fuel costs, maintenance costs, landfill fees, etc. and to fund the town’s share to decommission the landfill.

The rates will increase as follows:

Recycle cart collected bi-weekly	\$7.70	\$8.50	\$0.80

Also, please note that the garbage bins at the businesses, school, area/pool, Corcoran Place and Eatonia Oasis Living are for their use only as they pay for the rental of these bins. **THEY ARE NOT FOR PUBLIC USE SO PLEASE DO NOT DUMP YOUR GARBAGE IN THESE BINS.**

You can dump garbage in your own garbage cart or take it to the nuisance grounds. The nuisance grounds hours for ratepayers of the Town of Eatonia and the R.M. of Chesterfield are as follows:

WALL OF EXCELLENCE 2025

GORDON ARNOTT

LAROCK

Arnott started skating at 7 years old in Mantario. In 1949, Arnott moved to Kindersley with his aunt and uncle so that he could skate at an indoors rink.

Arnott was picked up to play with a few different teams. As a teenager, Arnott played with Kindersley's high school team. He also played with the

Kindersley Senior Klippers, playing against great players like the Allan brothers from Kerrobert who later played in the NHL. Arnott won several provincial titles and attended many camps for junior teams. At 15 he was asked to move to Saskatoon and play on a team there but he declined. In the summer of 1952, a scout invited Arnott to Winnipeg for the Detroit Redwings camp. Arnott and 4 players from Kerrobert took the train from Kindersley to Winnipeg. He was 16 years old. While in Winnipeg, the players each received

\$40 per week in spending money. Tommy Ivan, the head coach for the Detroit Redwings, had a long conversation with him about possibilities for the NHL. They wanted him to stay in Brandon to play on the junior team but he wasn't ready to move so far away at his age. In the fall of 1953, Arnott went to the New York Rangers camp but couldn't finish camp due to muscle aches and pains. He later found out the cause of it to be Polio. After his diagnosis, Arnott switched gears from playing to coaching. He coached his sons Greg and Derwin, winning the southern final 2 years in a row. He also coached the Eatonia Senior Huskies. Arnott figures he spent around 20 years coaching in Eatonia. Arnott played a role in the construction of the rink in Eatonia alongside other community members including Jim Martin. Arnott remembers bringing his tractor into town and using it to lift men up to work.

Arnott has fond memories of his time playing and coaching hockey.
