Victoria started the trend of women getting married in white. Their 21-year marriage ended when Prince Albert died at 42 years old. "Victoria Day", became a National Holiday after her death in 1901 and was celebrated on May 24th, her actual birthday. This created the

PUBLIC NOTICE OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

The Council of the Town of Eatonia is considering establishing an off-leash dog park on Block R3, Plan 82MJ15180, Ext 0 as per the highlighted section on the map below:



Zoning Bylaw No. 5/16 General Regulations:

As per Section 4.3 of the Zoning Bylaw, public parks are a permitted use in all zoning districts.

What is an Off-Leash Dog Park?

It will be a fenced area where residents have the opportunity to exercise dogs off-leash within a controlled environment without being in contravention of municipal bylaws.

What are the benefits of an Off-Leash Dog Park?

- Provide a place for dogs to expel energy safely, reducing barking and other behavior problems.
- Provide seniors and disabled dog owners an accessible place to exercise their companions.
- Promote public health and safety by creating a dedicated place where dogs can run free.
- Help build the positive aspects of our dog-friendly culture while reducing the roaming and dog waste that sometimes comes with it.
- Build community by providing an opportunity to socialize with other dog owners.

Public Hearing:

The Council will hold a public hearing in conjunction with their regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. on May 13, 2025, at the Town of Eatonia Council Chambers – 202 Main Street, Eatonia, SK to hear any person or group that wishes to comment on the proposed establishment of an off-leash dog park. The Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned at the town office by 5:00 p.m. on May 9, 2025.
