





West Central Junior Football team would like to invite you to come out and join our football team in the Fall of 2023. This team has been running since 2015, with the goal of creating a fun and safe environment for kids to learn more about the sport of football. This team is a “community” team which includes Eaton, Leader, Oyen, Marengo and surrounding areas and has no affiliation with any schools.

Kids going into Grades 6 to 8 in the Fall of 2023 are eligible to play on the team. Kids going into grade 5 in the fall of 2023 can practice with the team but are not able to play in games. This is a great way to learn about football and see if they enjoy it.




