

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE AT THE SCHOOL BY 6:20PM TO GET READY WITH THE GROUP.







A REPORT FROM SUN WEST SCHOOL DIVISION BOARD OF EDUCATION









Sun West had planned its annual online Public Meeting for March 28 but this had to be postponed and has been re-scheduled for the fall of 2024. The meeting was to have been hosted by members of the Sun West Student Leadership Program and a number of videos were prepared for the meeting focusing on success in Sun West School Division. These videos are available on the Sun West website and can be reached through the Q-R to the right.



MARCH HAPPENINGS

The Board of Education held its regular meeting on March 26, where it discussed and reviewed a number of topics. These included:

• The Board approved the 2024-25 school-year calendar.

The calendar has now been forwarded to the Ministry of Education for their approval. Once this is received, the calendar will be publicly distributed.

• The Board decided to discontinue the full-colour, Sun West picture wall calendar and replace it by providing schools with single-page, magnetized calendar.

Information on how to obtain one will be provided to schools after the Ministry of Education approves final calendar.

• The Board heard a report from the Superintendent responsible for Colony Schools. Student population continues to grow at Colony Schools and Sun West is colloborating with Colony officials to provide educational opportunities for these students.

• The Board decided to re-schedule the online Public Meeting to during Provincial Education Week, which usually takes place in October.
