(cans must be clean, with or without labels – no steel or auto parts)

#### Bathroom

Shampoo bottles Body wash bottles Conditioner bottles Plastic hair spray bottles Plastic shaving containers Toilet paper cores Tissue boxes Plastic Pill bottles

### Kitchen

Milk jugs & Milk cartons Creamer cartons & bottles Paper egg cartons Soup, Vegetable, and any other food cans Aluminum and tin cans Pie tins, Plastic Juice bottles Juice cans Yogurt containers Salad dressing containers Cereal boxes Pizza boxes – unsoiled

### Office

Office paper Catalogues, Phone books Sticky notes, Scrap paper Cardboard boxes flattened

#### Items not accepted

Glass, Styrofoam, ceramics, light bulbs, soiled cardboard, hazardous chemical containers, scrap metal, car parts, plastic toys, wood or household garbage NO PLASTIC WRAP NO PLASTIC BAGS NO FOOD CONTAINER LABELLED #1
