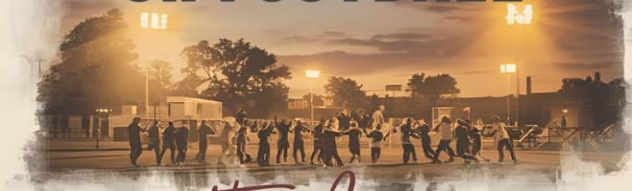

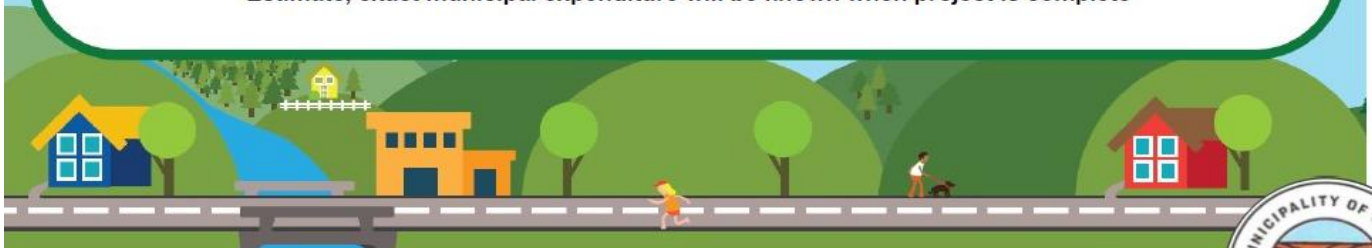

Parking Reminder

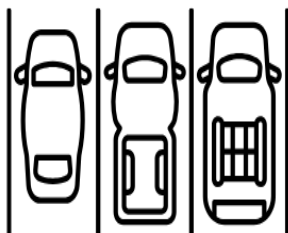


As winter approaches, please remember the following parking rules:

-Camping trailers, boat trailers, and other recreational vehicles must be removed from the street by November 1st and cannot be parked on the street again until April 1st.

-Beginning April 1st, trailers and recreational vehicles may only be parked on the street for up to 72 hours.

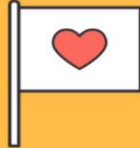
-Heavy trucks (semis), unregistered, and inoperable vehicles are not permitted to park on town streets at any time.





PRACTICAL PETIQUETTE

RESPECT SPACE



While YOUR dog might be just fine with other pets or people coming up to them to say "Hi!", others may not be.

Always ASK FIRST whether the pet owner is ok for you or your pet to approach and say hello.

SCOOP THE POOP



If you don't like picking up poop, don't have a dog ... it comes with the territory.

LEASH WALKING
