TOWN OF EATONIA UTILITY RATE INCREASE

*Utility rate increases will take affect on your

Below is a summary of the rate changes for residential services:

For non-residential service rate changes, please contact the office.

The Council is committed to maintaining a balance of water and sewer revenues that cover water and sewer expenditures and capital purchases. To accomplish this, rates need to increase over time to match with expenditure cost increases.

Waterworks are self-financing, where the users pay for the costs of the service. Self-financing utility works reduce pressure on property taxes.

Water and sewer revenue covers operating expenditures, such as waterworks salaries, benefits, training, power, heat, insurance, chemical treatments, repairs, supplies, maintenance, etc..

The cost of financial borrowing is not practical. The Town is proactively building a reserve for future capital projects such as sewer relining, water line replacement, or water treatment plant upgrades. Having funds set aside for these large projects is key to maintaining essential water services for our community.



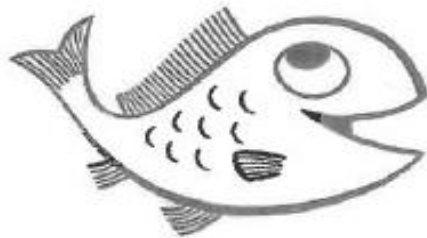
