The above candidates are running for the office of Councillor for the Town of Eatonia; you may only vote for two of the above candidates.

WHO CAN VOTE:

A person is eligible to vote in the town municipal by-election if the following requirements are met:

- At least 18 years old on election day;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months before by-election day;
AND EITHER;
 - A resident of the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months before by-election day;
- OR;**
 - An owner of assessable land for at least 3 consecutive months before by-election day.

ACCEPTABLE VOTER IDENTIFICATION:

The purpose of the voter ID requirements is to maintain the integrity of local election processes.

Your name and address must appear in some form on your voter identification documents. Bringing proper identification will ensure your voice is heard and will help your local by-election run as smoothly as possible.

To prove identity, a voter shall provide to the election officials the following:

- One (1) piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality, or a government agency that contains a photograph of the voter and his/her name and address;
- Two (2) pieces of information prescribed in *The Local Government Election Regulations, 2015* each of which establishes the voter's name and at least one of which establishes the voter's address.

A Canadian passport is not an acceptable form of photo identification because it does not contain your address. However, a Canadian passport can be used as identification if paired with another document that has your name and address on it.

For a complete list of acceptable ID view Appendix D – Table 1 page 76-78 of *The Local Government Election Regulations, 2015* or stop by the Town Office to view the list.

PLEASE BE AWARE:

Dogs and cats are required to be on a leash and under the complete control of their keeper while off the owner’s private property.

New pet in the family? Please license your dog or cat with the Town as soon as the pet is over 6 months old.

- **Pet licenses are for the lifetime of the pet**
- Spayed/neutered pet \$15.00
- Intact pet \$20.00

Need a replacement tag for your licensed pet? Stop by the Town Office and purchase a replacement tag for \$5.00 + GST

Failure To License an Animal	1 st Offence	\$50/animal (If paid within 10 Days) + License Fees	\$100/animal (If paid after 10 Days) + License Fees
Animal at Large	1 st Offence	\$50/animal (If paid within 10 Days)	\$100/animal (If paid after 10 Days)

The Eatonia District Health Foundation would like to update you on their activities and involvement in the community.

The Foundation Board is represented by the following members – Carol Peters representing the Town of Eatonia, Leah Cooper and Doug Bredy representing the R.M. of Chesterfield, Vicki Oomen representing the R.M. of Newcombe, Fritz Eckstein and Brennan (BJ) Somerville, members at large and Cheryl Bailey, Secretary-Treasurer.

The Foundation owns and operates the handi bus that you see in our community. The handi bus is available to seniors and people with disabilities for medical appointments to the health centre, to Kindersley for appointments, community events, etc. The Board is organizing scheduled trips once a month for the handi bus to go to Kindersley for shopping and other appointments people need to do. The fees for rides are \$3.00 for in-town trips and \$10.00 for the scheduled monthly trip to Kindersley.

Our volunteer drivers are Vicki Oomen, Richard Adams, Craig Bews, Duane Cridland and Darcy Scott. Without their commitment to providing this service, the handi bus would not operate. The Board would like to express their appreciation to them.

The apartment building at 305 – 1st Street West is also owned and operated by the Eatonia District Health Foundation. There are four suites that are rented in the building.

The Eatonia District Health Foundation has helped to support Eatonia Oasis Living by providing a grant to help with ongoing educational expenses for the staff and the use of the handi bus for social excursions for the residents.

The Eatonia District Health Foundation is funded by money held from the municipalities, handi bus fares, a provincial grant for the bus and the rent collected at the apartment.

We appreciate all your generosity and encourage people to use the handi bus.
