Management's Responsibility

The municipality's management is responsible for the preparation and preparation of the accompanying consolidated financial statements in accordance with Canadian public sector accounting standards (PSAS). The preparation of the statements necessarily includes selecting appropriate accounting principles and methods, and making decisions affecting the measurement of transactions in which objective judgements and estimates by management is required.

In discharging its responsibilities for the integrity and fair presentation of the consolidated financial statements, management designs and maintains the necessary accounting, budget and other related internal controls to provide reasonable assurance that transactions are appropriately authorized and accurately recorded, that assets are properly accounted for and safeguarded, and that financial records are properly maintained to provide reliable information for the preparation of the consolidated financial statements.

The Council is composed of elected officials who are not employees of the municipality. The Council is responsible for overseeing management in the performance of its financial reporting responsibilities. The Council fulfils these responsibilities by reviewing the financial information prepared by management and discussing relevant matters with external auditors. The Council is also responsible for recommending the appointment of the municipality's external auditors.

CHBB Chartered Professional Accountants, an independent firm of *Chartered Professional Accountants*, is appointed by the Council to audit the consolidated financial statements and report directly to them; their report follows. The external auditors have full and free access to, and meet periodically and separately with, both the Council and management to discuss their audit findings.

Residents of Eatonia and the R.M. of Chesterfield No. 261 can continue to take household and yard waste to the Transfer Station during operating hours.

Please note the following changes:

Yard waste in plastic bags must be torn open, and the plastic disposed of separately. Plastic bags cannot be burned and are not accepted at the Transfer Station burn pile.

Paper Yard Waste Bags (must state they are biodegradable) are accepted and can be purchased from the local Hardware Store or other retailers.

What do I need to do to purchase?

1. Take the FREE online training through SARM
2. Wait 2-3 days for the certification to be updated on the online system
3. Fill out prescribed paperwork and bring or email the completed forms to the office (Contact the RM for the forms)
4. Come to the office to purchase



NOTE: Due to limited quantities, we MAY have to limit sales per certified individual



IMPORTANT

Before you purchase, ensure you meet all this criteria

- You **MUST** have your municipality set as Chesterfield for your training, if it is set to any other RM we can not sell you strychnine
- **Only the individual** who has taken the strychnine training is eligible for purchase and pick up, no one else can receive the poison on your behalf
- You **MUST** fill out the required paperwork prior and post purchase of strychnine, failure to do so will put the RM at risk of future strychnine purchases
- We can only sell between **July 15- September 1, 2026**
- Certification **MUST** be current, please check the date of the
