PLEASE RESPECT WATERING HOURS:

Even numbered properties can water on **EVEN** days / Odd numbered properties can water on **ODD** days
Watering is permitted between 7 and 10 mornings and evenings

To ensure there is enough water for everyone, the Town asks you to please respect watering hours and days.

Violations of Bylaw No. 6/10 could result in penalties:

First offence - \$100.00 / Second and subsequent offences - \$250.00 each

If you have seeded a new area with grass, you may **apply for a watering permit**. Watering permits allow property owners to water every day for 2 weeks to help establish new grass. Watering permits are not intended for filling in grass patches.

Your cooperation is appreciated.

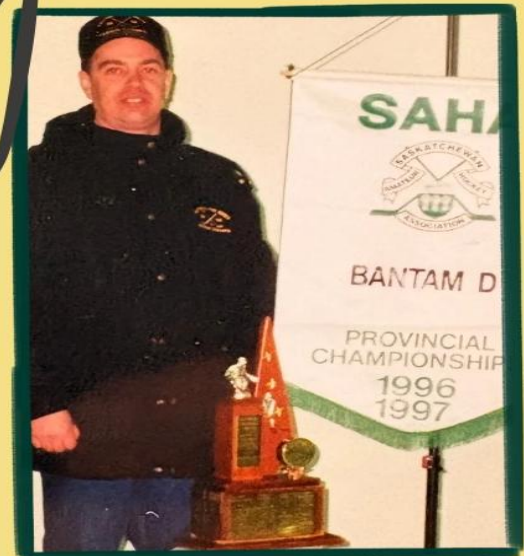
